

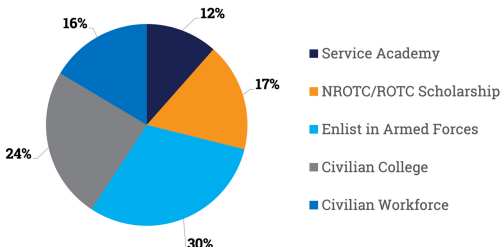

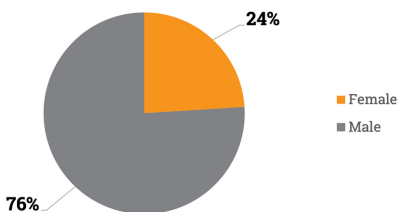

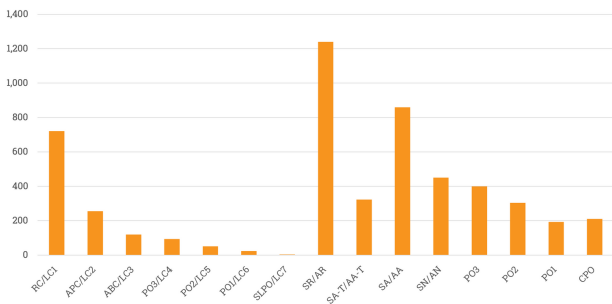
### Graduating Cadet Profile



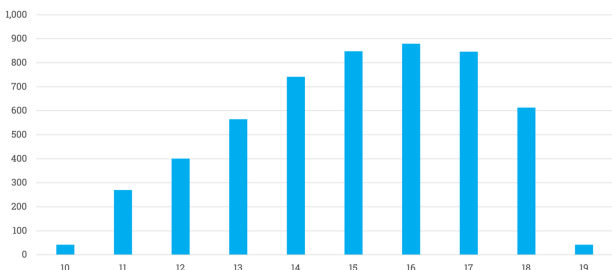
### Cadet Demographics
