A) Drill Fee: \$30.



D) HYDRATE. We will spend a significant amount of time outside. HYDRATE prior to arrival. DO NOT show up dehydrated.

F) SWIMMING. Males will wear appropriate swim trunks and have a shirt for transiting. Females will wear a one piece and have a shirt or over garment for transiting.

Navy Bight of History: SEALS (Sea, Air, and Land) Origins. Although not formally founded until 1962, the modern-day U.S. Navy SEALs trace their roots to World War II. The United States Military recognized the need for the covert reconnaissance of landing beaches and coastal defenses. As a result, the joint Army, Marine Corps, and Navy Amphibious Scout and Raider School was established in 1942 at Fort Pierce, Florida. The Scouts and Raiders were formed in September of that year, just nine months after the attack on Pearl Harbor, from the Observer Group, a joint U.S. Army-Marine-Navy unit.
