NOTES:


A) Drill Fee: \$30.

B) Disposable plastic bottles are not allowed. Refillable hydration bottles such as Nalgene, Swiss Gear etc... are allowed. **DO NOT FORGET WATER BOTTLE OR CAMELBAK.**

C) Visitors. Arrive in weather appropriate comfortable clothing. You are authorized to stay the night with the option to also depart at 2000 (8pm). If you stay the night, please bring appropriate sleeping attire, sleeping mat with sleeping bag, toiletries, and change of clothes.

D) Inspection. Sea Cadets and League Cadets need to bring your entire Service Dress Blues. Ensure you have your white tshirt, black socks, dress shoes, white hat, neckerchief, pants, blouse. If you HAVE NOT been issued dress blues you will wear your NWUs for the inspection.

E) Fire Academy. Be prepared to change into NWUs at the Fire Fighting Academy. This may require you bring an additional smaller bag to carry your uniform in.

Navy Bight of History: The fire onboard the USS Bonhomme Richard (LHD 6). Witnesses reported that an explosion occurred at about 8:50 a.m. on 12 July 2020 aboard Bonhomme Richard while in her homeport at Naval Base San Diego undergoing maintenance. The fire raged for 5 days. On 30 November 2020, Navy officials said that attempting to repair the damage and return Bonhomme Richard to service would take between five and seven years and cost an estimated \$2.5 billion to \$3.2 billion. Instead, the decision was made to withdraw the ship from service and, following extensive component recovery, have her sold for scrap. <https://thisdayinusmilhist.wordpress.com/>
