
C) Visitors. Please arrive in weather appropriate comfortable clothing. You are authorized to stay the night with the option to also depart at 2000 (8pm). If you stay the night, please bring appropriate sleeping attire, sleeping mat with sleeping bag, toiletries, and change of clothes.

D) Attendance. Starting in September we will be enforcing an 75% attendance rating. This has always been a Sea Cadet requirement, but was relaxed during COVID. There are valid reasons that will excuse you from portions of the day and still receive credit and those typically include school activities and family vacations (out of area).

E) Dress Blues. If you have a Dress Blue Uniform you need to bring all the items (top, bottom, neckerchief, ribbon rack, white hat) to drill. We will verify condition/fit as well as update if you need rank, new sizes, etc.

F) COMMS PLAN. My apologies for our struggle in establishing a standard communication platform. Navy Bight of History: The grade of Chief Petty Officer was established on 1 April 1893 for the United States Navy. The United States Congress first authorized the Coast Guard to use the promotion to Chief Petty Officer on 18 May 1920. Chief petty officer is also the final cadet grade in the United States Naval Sea Cadet Corps .
