
A) Drill Fee: \$30.

**Navy Bight of History:** The Navy Has Its Own Way of Saying "Well Done". Through World War II, sailors who did well were told "Tare Victor George", which was code for "well done." After the war, the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) was formed and it standardized communications. NATO created a system of B-flags for administrative communication. The last B-flag was BZ. The Allied Naval Signal Book created the phonetics for each letter and BZ became Bravo Zulu.

### Directions to Naval Reserve Center (NRC) (formerly NOSC)

1. Put SAMMC into your GPS - 3551 Roger Brooke Dr, Fort Sam Houston, TX 78234.
2. **IF YOU HAVE BASE ACCESS** continue onto base. **IF YOU DO NOT HAVE BASE ACCESS** upon arrival you will meet with an Active Duty Sailor to grant you access.
3. Drill is located at the Naval Reserve Center (NRC) (formerly NOSC) is located at 3837 Binz-Engleman Rd, San Antonio, TX 78219. It is the building across from the hospital and next to the parking garage with the big MARINE CORPS emblem on the side. **DO NOT PUT THE NRC ADDRESS INTO YOUR GPS.** It will bring you to a closed gate.
